

Cleaning instructions for moving



GENERAL – ALL ROOMS

- ◆ All woodwork (doors, doorframes, window frames) window sills, radiators, plug sockets/switches etc should be wiped down. Walls should be cleaned if necessary (painted surfaces)
- ◆ Surface pipes, coving and valves for ventilation should be vacuum cleaned.
- ◆ Windows – all sides should be cleaned. In temperatures of less than -5 degrees, only inside and outside should be cleaned.
- ◆ Wardrobes and other fixed storage spaces should be cleaned.
- ◆ Fixed fittings/lamps should be cleaned.
- ◆ Floors including skirting boards should be vacuumed and wiped down. Lino mats should be polished. Use mild cleaning materials, preferably soap.

KITCHEN

- ◆ Kitchen cupboards should be cleaned inside and out, as well as on the top and bottom sides.
- ◆ Refrigerators and freezers must be defrosted and cleaned, refrigerator interior parts need to be washed in the sink. Freestanding cupboards should also be cleaned on the back side.
- ◆ Cookers, ovens and all hobs/accessories should be thoroughly cleaned. If possible, you should also clean behind and under the cooker.
- ◆ The fans should be cleaned on the underside and the top side, the removable filter should be washed in the sink.
- ◆ Dishwasher should be cleaned on the outside and edges, including the bottom strainer.
- ◆ Drainer and sink should be cleaned - please use Svinto or similar product.
- ◆ Tiles/splashbacks should be cleaned; above the stove and sink. Remaining walls should be cleared of stains.

BATHROOM AND TOILET

- ◆ Wash basin, bathtub, shower/ shower enclosure, toilet, taps and tiled walls should be cleaned and descaled if necessary. Freestanding bathtubs should also be cleaned under and behind.
- ◆ Floor drains (and water traps) should be rinsed and cleaned.
- ◆ Bathroom cabinet and fixtures should be cleaned.
- ◆ Painted walls/walls with wet room wallpaper should be wiped down.

BASEMENT AND LOFT STORAGE AREAS

- ◆ Should be completely empty, vacuumed.
- ◆ Shelves/interior storage should be wiped. Leave the space locked.

BALCONY

- ◆ The floor should be cleaned (any trellis / outdoor mat or other surface / floor should be removed)
- ◆ Fence wiped down (any wind shelter/flower boxes should be removed)
- ◆ Windows of glass-covered balconies should be cleaned.

If the cleaning is found to be sub-standard, the landlord will have the apartment cleaned and charge the cost to you.
